Register for BPAA Girl's Slow Pitch and Fast Pitch Softball one of three ways

Slow Pitch Softball: 8 and Under (8U) (coach pitch). 10U, 12U, 14U, 16U, 19U (girls pitch).

- Games played in Brooklyn Park primarily on weeknights in Brooklyn Park.
- Opening day on Sunday, May 2nd for 8U, 10U and 12U.
- End of season weekend tournament July 9-11th.



Fast Pitch Softball: 10U, 12U, 14U & 16U (girls pitch).

- A traveling league with games played weekdays mostly in the Northern and Western Suburbs.
- Most teams also play some weekend tournaments during the season.
- Competitive tryouts are held in early March to determine teams

All Slow Pitch and Fast Pitch Divisions are formed by age (as of 1/1/10) according to USSSA rules.
